

# Intro to Comprehensive Scan™

The Comprehensive Scan technology performs a detailed scan of the frequencies from over 130 organs, cells, bones, and chromosomes.

To conduct the Comprehensive Scan, you will need to use the Bone Conductor Transducer Headset™.

The Comprehensive Scan provides a graphical report that displays variances from blueprint homeostasis ranging from 1-9. Numbers 1-4 represent an underactive or hypofunctioning frequencies. Number 5 represents the optimal stage of blueprint balance. Numbers 6-9 represent an overactive or hyperfunctioning frequencies.

Frequency optimization will pick up anything out of range and will generate canceling frequencies that will help your organs and system achieve a state of homeostasis (complete balance).

This mode of technology offers a comprehensive library of information that is constantly being upgraded on a regular basis.

- ♦ **Organs and Cells Report** – Covers the cerebral cortex, brain sagittal, pancreas, prostate, liver, kidneys, lungs, blood, meninges, adrenal, cells, digestive system, skin, thyroid, gastrointestinal, chromosomes, basal ganglia, breasts, female sagittal, mitochondria, rectum, reproductive system, stomach, and urinary.
- ♦ **Vein's report** – Covers the head, upper body, lower body, arms, and legs.
